Mayor Boone called the emergency meeting to order at 2:30 p.m. for the purpose of considering Resolution 2020-17.

As reported at the October meeting, Tamara Lowney from Itasca Economic Development Corporation reviewed that she has been working on an incentive package for a regional manufacturing company to expand into the e2ip facility. Part of this package is an application to the Job Creation Fund Program which requires support from a unit of government. Resolution 2020-17 provides that support. There is no financial obligation or reporting requirements for the City tied to this application. ***Motion by Boone, seconded by Gustafson to adopt Resolution 2020-17, motion carried unanimously.***

Lowney briefly explained another potential piece of the incentive package, an application to the Minnesota Investment Fund. She is gathering information on this program and will address the Council about it once she has all that information.
